Join us for a **6-week Bible study**.



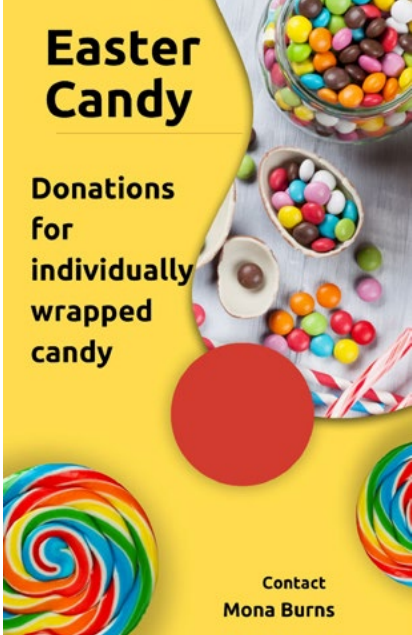






Armory Road/Route 20 between Dukes Rd and Omar Rd will be closed until May 16. *Weather permitting.*
